In August 2001, Bill and Dave Wettstain, life long residents of Hancock Co started a carry out bar-b-que restaurant, Bill & Dave's Smokin' Pit., located at 1527 11th street Tell City IN., becoming well known for their slow cooked ribs, pork, and chicken.

The business began as carry-out only in a small building on Main Street and grew so fast that they moved in 2002 to their present location with ample seating capacity and much needed catering facilities and kitchen. Now they offer dine- in, carry- out, and catering.

To date, Bill and Dave's Smokin Pit offers complete catering for weddings, graduation parties, family and class reunions, church picnics, and banquets, company picnics, corporate events, receptions for new businesses, birthday parties, and luncheons for company training sessions. Breakfast is also served for early business, and civic events.

Catering is designed by customer request from hors d'oeuvres to complete meals. Bill and Dave's also offer custom cooking at Thanksgiving and Christmas which keeps some of their staff cooking 24 hrs continuously.

Not only has the Wettstain family kept all members of their family working for several years, they have several long time employees which contribute greatly. Elaine Reisz and Nick Dennis have been with Bill and Dave almost since they opened their present location. They have given many students from Hancock County and Perry County their first job, who enjoyed making gas and spending money.

Chris Wettstain and Katy Wettstain- Arison both worked at the restaurant while attending college. Katy still works for her Dad and Grandpa and is in charge of several phases of the operation.


