

HANCOCK COUNTY GAME & FISH CLUB
RULES & REGULATIONS

- The speed limit in all areas of the farm is 5mph. Please watch for children playing.
- Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult in all areas of the farm, with the exception of the shooting range, which requires adult supervision for any persons under the age of 18.
- Firearms are only permitted on the shooting range, unless you are authorized to provide security for the farm by the Board of Directors.
- **ALL PETS WILL BE ON A LEASH AND UNDER THE OWNER'S CONTROL AT ALL TIMES WHILE ON THE PROPERTY.**
- **NO PETS WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE SWIMMING AREA.**
- No alcoholic beverages are to be brought or consumed on the property.
- Members may bring guests on the property and pay the fees designated for a particular activity.
- No more than five guests per membership.
- No hunting on the property.
- Do not pollute the property or lake with trash or fish waste. All trash is to be bagged and placed in the dumpster at the main entrance.
- No horses or ATV's permitted on the property.
- **Be considerate of others. Keep noise at a respectable level, especially after 10pm.**

Fishing

- All state licenses for boats and fishing apply at the lake.
- The use of gas motors are prohibited on the lake.
- Do not put leftover bait in the lake.
- Fishing is limited to pole and line only. Limit of three poles per person.
- Do not catch or harm the grass carp. They help promote a healthy lake.
- No fishing, boating, camping, or fires are permitted in the beach area.
- The fishing fee for member guests is \$3.00 per guest per day and must be placed in the red box at the main entrance by the shower house.
- Pay close attention to posted signs regarding daily catch and size limits of the fish.

Swimming

- Swim at your own risk.
- Swimming is only permitted from 9am – 7pm.
- No glass bottles permitted in swimming/beach area.
- The swimming fee for member guests is \$1.00 per guest per day and must be placed in the red box at the main entrance by the shower house.

Camping

- Camping permitted in designated areas only.
- Camping is **limited to 7 days** and you **MUST** be with your tent or camper at all times. At the end of the 7 days the tent/camper **Must** be removed from the property for 3 days or we will remove it for you. This will allow others a chance to camp as well.
- No tent camping on water and electric sites. They are reserved for campers that require electricity. A fee of \$10.00 per day payable in advance with no refunds.
- Be responsible with camp fires. All state, federal, and local burn regulations apply. Be sure all fires are extinguished prior to leaving your campsite.
- We have provided a dumpster at the main entrance where all members and their guests will dispose of their trash daily
- Camping fee for member guest is \$1.00 per person per day and must be placed in the red box at the main entrance by the shower house.

Shooting Range

- All members and their guest are required to clean up all targets and debris from the grassy areas after they are done shooting.
- No one under 18 years of age is permitted on the shooting range without adult supervision.
- The fee for all guests is \$3.00 per person per day and must be placed in the red box at the main entrance by the shower house.
- Do not damage or shoot the Hancock Co. Game & Fish property.

THESE RULES ARE NOT NEGOTIABLE AND IF THEY ARE NOT FOLLOWED TO THE LETTER CAN RESULT IN THE TERMINATION OF YOUR MEMBERSHIP. EACH MEMBER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR GUEST AT ALL TIMES WHILE THEY ARE ON THE PROPERTY.
